The Historical Column by Evelyn Bastow

Sadly we must report that two former members of the club and a former coach have passed away in the last few months. We remember them well.

Mary Salter, a member of the club from 1950 through the 70's was a former board member, skated on the adult session and helped on the junior session. Her four children also skated with the club and her daughter Maggie Salmoni currently coaching in Sarnia still brings skaters to Great Lakes. Mary was always an enthusiastic volunteer for the club. She passed away on November 14/03 at the age of 84.

Nathalie Hay, joined the club in 1950 and her late husband Clifford skated the Adult Session until 1998. The entire Hay family loved to skate in Carnivals and they also hosted the After the Carnival Party. Clifford served on the board and Nathalie was a great worker for the club. She passed away on December 21/03.

<u>Dennis Silverthorne</u>, a well respected coach for over 30 years in London, passed away on January 4/04 at the age of 81 after a long illness. Dennis was Junior British Champion in 1939, and with his sister Winnie was British Pairs Champion and fourth at world's in 1947 and fifth at Olympics in 1948. He coached at LSC, and Ilderton Skating Club before moving on to operate his own school for 20 years. He will be missed by his former pupils and skating friends.
